Enclosed for your information is a copy of the proposed report of the Chief of Engineers on the Encinitas-Solana Beach, Coastal Storm Damage Reduction Project, San Diego County, California. The final environmental impact statement (FEIS) is being filed with the Environmental Protection Agency and is being made available to interested parties for review and comment pursuant to regulations of the President's Council on Environmental Quality for implementing NEPA (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508).
