PUBLIC NOTICE OF VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING FOR SANTA FE DAM RECREATION AREA MASTER PLAN REVISION LOS ANGELES COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Los Angeles District is revising the Santa Fe Dam Recreation Area Master Plan. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a standard in-person meeting will be substituted with two virtual public meetings, scheduled as follows:

DATE: June 15, 2022

TIME: from 2 to 3 p.m. and from 7 to 8 p.m.

The meeting will provide attendees with information regarding the revision content, process and general schedule. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask Corps' staff questions. A 30-day comment period will begin June 15, 2022, and end July 14, 2022, during which the public can send comments, suggestions and concerns.

The master plan as defined by the Corps is a strategic land use management document that guides the comprehensive management and development of all recreational, natural and cultural resources throughout the life of the water resource development project. In general, it defines "how" the resources will be managed for public use and resource conversation.

Revision of the master plan will not address in detail the technical operational aspects of the dam as related to flood-risk management or water conservation. The master plan study area will include the Santa Fe Dam and basin, and all adjacent recreational and natural resources properties owned by the Corps.

Public participation is critical to the successful revision of the master plan. Information provided at the public meeting, including the existing 2011 Santa Fe Dam Master Plan, may be viewed on the Corps website at the following link beginning June 1, 2022:
