COMPENSATORY MITIGATION WORKSHOP (update)

The Los Angeles District Regulatory Division will host a compensatory mitigation workshop. The workshop will be open to the public and is intended to present mitigation-related policies and procedures, specifically the 2015 South Pacific Division (SPD) Regional Compensatory Mitigation and Monitoring Guidelines, the SPD Standard Operating Procedure for Determination of Mitigation Ratios, and the SPD Uniform Performance Standards for Compensatory Mitigation Requirements.
