I am responding to your letter of May 22, 2013, in which you requested that the approved jurisdictional determination for the Salt River Materials Group's proposed development known as the Olive Avenue Property, dated January 11, 2005, be extended for another five years. The jurisdictional determination includes waters of the United States associated with the Agua Fria River in Section 25, Township 03 North, Range 01 West, Phoenix, Maricopa County, Arizona.

The previous jurisdictional determination is hereby extended an additional five years until June 18, 2018. Any discharge of dredged and/or fill material into the designated jurisdictional areas may require a Section 404 permit from the Corps of Engineers.
