The purpose of this Special Public Notice is to announce the relocation of the Los Angeles District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) Prado Dam Regulatory Field Office to new facilities in the City of Riverside, Riverside County, California. The Corps will be located in Suite 100 of 1451 Research Park Drive, occupying a portion of the building where the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) is currently located. The move-in is scheduled for the week of July 25, 2011. While our goal is to be operational as soon as possible, due to the logistical issues involved with any major move, we do not anticipate being fully functional before the beginning of August 2011. From Interstate 215 (I-215), take the Columbia Avenue exit (exit 35). Turn RIGHT onto East La Cadena Drive, followed by an immediate LEFT onto Columbia Avenue. Follow Columbia Avenue approximately one and a half miles to Research Park Drive. Turn RIGHT onto Research Park Drive.

The third building on the right is the Bureau of Indian Affairs office. The new Corps of Engineers office is shared with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
