Your request of June 23, 2014 for a time extension to install one of the five approved cranes associated with the Phase II permit and install the single crane associated with the Phase III permit for the Berths 97-109 China Shipping Phase II and Phase III permit(s) (Permit No. SPL-2003-01029-SDM), is authorized. The permit(s) authorized you to discharge fill into, and construct structures in and over navigable waters of the U.S., in association with the project in the Port of Los Angeles, city and county of Los Angeles, California.

Under the provisions of 33 Code of Federal Regulations 325.6(d), the start date is to remain the same and the completion date is extended for both the Phase II and Phase III permit(s) from July 10, 2014 to **December 31, 2015**.

The terms and conditions of Permit No. SPL-2003-01029-SDM, except as changed herein, remain in full force and effect.
