DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY NATIONWIDE PERMIT VERIFICATION

Dear Ms. Donofrio:

I am responding to your August 26, 2013 request (SPL-2010-01072-KWG) for a Department of the Army permit. Your proposed project, Silverbell Road Widening; Phase One, Grant to Goret Roads, is located at Township 13 South, Range 13 East, Section 33, within the limits of the City of Tucson, Pima County, Arizona. This project would result in a discharge of 0.34 acres dredged and/or fill material into jurisdictional Waters of the United States. Therefore, pursuant to section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. 1344; 33 C.F.R. parts 323 and 330), your proposed project requires a Department of the Army permit.

I have determined construction of your proposed project would comply with Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 14, Linear Transportation Projects, if constructed as described in your application. Specifically, and as shown on the attached drawing(s)/map(s), you are authorized to conduct the following regulated activities:

1. Site (Wash) 1: Greasewood Wash

Authorized activities include remove existing drop inlet structures and replace with new 30' concrete drop inlet structure, construct wigwalls, grade channel up to 115-feet downstream of structures, and extend existing box culvert 19-feet upstream and 5-feet downstream. Permanent impacts will be 0.09 acres and temporary impacts will be 0.03 acres.

2. Site (Wash) 2: Nursery Wash

Authorized activities include the new construction of an 8' x 3' x 124' box culvert, a 10' x 6' x 309' RCBC with connection to three, 36' RCP's downstream. Permanent impacts will be 0.20 acres and temporary impacts will be 0.05 acres.

3. Site (Wash) 3: Introspect Wash

Authorized activities include extending the existing 48' x 127' RCP 10' upstream and 30' downstream and installing new concrete wingwall with a 30' apron, grade 30'

downstream, and a 30'access upstream. Permanent impacts will be 0.02 acres and temporary impacts will be 0.01 acres.

4. Site (Wash) 4: Painted Hills

Authorized activities include extending 6 - 10' x 6' x 128' RCBC by 10' upstream and 27' downstream, install concrete wingwalls with a 20' apron, and remove existing drop structure and install new 30' inlet structure. Permanent impacts will be 0.02 acres and temporary impacts will be 0.01 acres.

For this NWP verification letter to be valid, you must comply with all of the terms and conditions in Enclosure 1. Furthermore, you must comply with the non-discretionary Special Conditions listed below:

- 1. The Permittee shall mitigate for the permanent loss of 0.34 acres of Waters of the United States associated with the roadway improvements for the Silverbell Road Widening Project; Phase One, Grant to Goret Roads. The Permittee shall purchase 0.34 acres from an approved In-Lieu Fee Program and submit confirmation of receipt to the Corps Phoenix Office by December 31, 2013.
- 2. The Permittee shall provide notification, either written or verbal, to the Corps of Engineers at least one week prior to the start of work, as to the anticipated beginning and ending dates of construction. The Permittee shall maintain the activity authorized by this permit in good condition and in conformance with the terms and conditions of this permit
- 3. A copy of the permit shall be on the job site at all times during construction. The Permittee shall provide a copy of this permit to all construction representatives. The Permittee shall require that all construction representatives read this authorization in its entirety and acknowledge they understand its contents and their responsibility to ensure compliance with all general and special conditions contained herein.
- 4. The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality issued a waiver to individual certification signed on September 17, 2013. The permittee shall comply with all the 401 conditions that are a part of the NWP 14. A copy of this letter is enclosed.
- 5. The Permittee shall ensure that all project areas disturbed by construction-related activities are stabilized and restored to their pre-project conditions/contours, to the maximum extent possible, upon project completion. Watercourse morphology shall be re-established to match pre-construction configurations. Areas disturbed above the ordinary high water mark will be reseeded with a locally native plant species.
- 6. Unless specifically authorized all temporary construction access, staging activities, and stockpiling shall be located outside of the waters of the U.S. The location of these activities shall be sited to minimize the removal of mature trees, to utilize previously disturbed areas to the extent practicable, and to minimize the total area of disturbance.
- 7. The Permittee shall not discharge dredged or fill material while constructing this project or any other phase of this project, other than the permitted activities identified above.

8. The Permittee shall allow representatives from this office to inspect the authorized activity at any time deemed necessary to ensure that it is being or has been accomplished within the terms and conditions of the permit.

This verification is valid through March 18, 2017. If on March 18, 2017 you have commenced or are under contract to commence the permitted activity you will have an additional twelve (12) months to complete the activity under the present NWP terms and conditions. However, if I discover noncompliance or unauthorized activities associated with the permitted activity we can exercise discretionary authority and thereby modify, suspend, or revoke this specific verification at an earlier date in accordance with procedures in 33 C.F.R. § 330.4(e) and 33 C.F.R. § 330.5(c) or (d). At the national level the Chief of Engineers at any time prior to the expiration of a NWP may chose to modify, suspend, or revoke the nationwide use of a NWP after following procedures set forth in 33 C.F.R. § 330.5. It is incumbent upon you to comply with all of the terms and conditions of this NWP verification and to remain informed of any change to the NWPs.

A NWP does not grant any property rights or exclusive privileges. Additionally, it does not authorize any injury to the property, rights of others, nor does it authorize interference with any existing or proposed Federal project. Furthermore, it does not obviate the need to obtain other Federal, state, or local authorizations required by law.
