Interested parties are invited to attend the Virgin River Comprehensive Watershed Analysis meeting. This is one of five such watershed studies underway nationwide, with a goal to complete "*at full federal expense, comprehensive analyses that examine multi-jurisdictional use and management of water resources on a watershed or regional scale*".

The study will produce a needs analysis, a floodplain management strategy, and a watershed strategy. Stakeholders identified the following major issues at the August 2006 kickoff meeting: floodplain management, land use planning, invasive species, threatened and endangered species and water supply.

The meeting will include updates on study progress and presentations pertaining to ongoing work throughout the watershed. 
