SECTION I -

Blocks 1 through 4. To be completed by Corps of Engineers.

SECTION II -

Block 1. Agency's Name. Enter the name of the Agency responsible for the Operation and Maintenance of the impacted federally-constructed facility. If unsure, check the project listing on the District's web site or check with the local flood control district.

Block 2. Permit Applicant. Please provide the name of the officer and title of the person who will be the signatory of the Permit. Upon approval of the permit, the signatory shall represent and warrant that he / she is duly authorized to execute and bind the Agency (*in Block 5*) to the terms and conditions contained within the Permit.

Block 2b. Permit Applicant POC. Please provide the name and contact information for the Point of Contact for this permit application, including the number where you can usually be reached during normal business hours and the full e-mail address.

Block 2e. Third Party Permittee. Optionally, indicate name of third-party individual or agency who is proposing the alteration / modification. Note that should a Section 408 Permit be granted to the non-federal sponsor for work to be performed by a third party, the non-federal sponsor should ensure that the permit conditions are incorporated into the final approval to the third party, and the Corps will hold the Non-Federal Sponsor fully accountable for non-compliance.

Block 1. Proposed Project Name or Title. Please provide name identifying the proposed project (*i.e., Landmark Bridge Replacement, Burned Hills Trail Project or East Town Infrastructure Project*).

Block 2. Name of Stream, River, or Water Body. Please provide the name of the stream, river, or other waterway involving the federally-constructed project that would be directly impacted by the activity.

Block 3. Corps Reference Station, River mile, or nearby Landmark. Provide approximate Corps reference station of the facility. If unknown, provide reference to the site from a known location or landmark.

Block 4a-b. Location of Proposed Project. Provide the latitude and longitude for the proposed project.

Block 5. Project Description. Provide a concise and accurate narrative of the project and what is being requested to be permitted.

Block 6. Type of Project. Select appropriate box for the type(s) of projects being proposed that will connect to or impact an existing federally-constructed facility.

Block 7. Nature of Activity. Describe the overall activity or project. Give appropriate dimensions of structures such as wing walls, dikes (*identify the materials to be used in construction, as well as the methods by which the work is to be done*), or excavations (*length, width, and height*). Indicate whether discharge of dredged or fill material is involved. Also, identify any structure to be constructed on a fill, piles or float supported platforms. Please describe, in detail, what you wish to do. If more space is needed, attach an extra sheet of paper marked Block 15 continuation.

Block 8a-b. Categorical Permission. Certain types of requests may meet criteria established under a Categorical Permission. The specific activities are listed on the District's web site. Check whether this application is intended to be covered under one of the listed Categorical Permissions.

Block 9. Project Purpose. Describe the purpose and need for the proposed project. What will it be used for and why? Also include a brief description of any related activities to be developed as the result of the proposed project. Give the approximate dates you plan to both begin and complete all work.

Block 10a-b. Environmental Reports. Prior to issuance of the 408 permit, a document is prepared that assesses the environmental impacts of a proposed Federal Action. List what environmental documents have been prepared for the proposed project and the dates published, or anticipated date of publishing.

Block 11a-b. Regulatory Permits. Section 408 is not a permit action handled by the Corps Regulatory Program, although, activities of this proposed project may also require evaluation by Regulatory pursuant to Section 10 / 404 / 103.
