LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

The south branch of Arroyo Conejo Creek (SBAC) is located in the Calleguas Creek Watershed. The creek passes through the City of Thousand Oaks, about 40 miles northwest of downtown Los Angeles. SBAC begins in the Santa Monica Mountains, southwest of the City of Thousand Oaks. The creek drains approximately 45 square miles and is currently unable to convey a 100-year event in several reaches of the creek. The creek converges with the lower Calleguas Creek, which drains in the Pacific Ocean at Mugu Lagoon. Funding is under the Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) Section 205.

AUTHORIZATION:

WRDA 07, Section 1002(a) (7) - Public Law 110-114; CAP Section 205; project limit is \$7M Fed.

ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2021:

Funds will be used to complete the identification of existing conditions and determine a focused array of alternatives to reduce flood risk along the south branch of Arroyo Conejo Creek.
