LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

The City of Norwalk, located in the southwest part of Los Angeles County, is primarily a residential community with a population of approximately 105,500. The proposed multi-year program would provide for the upgrading of the City's water distribution, transmission mains and fire system, in order to provide increased system reliability, water quality and fire protection. The initial project would provide for approximately 12,875 feet of distribution pipeline replacement in the South Service Area.

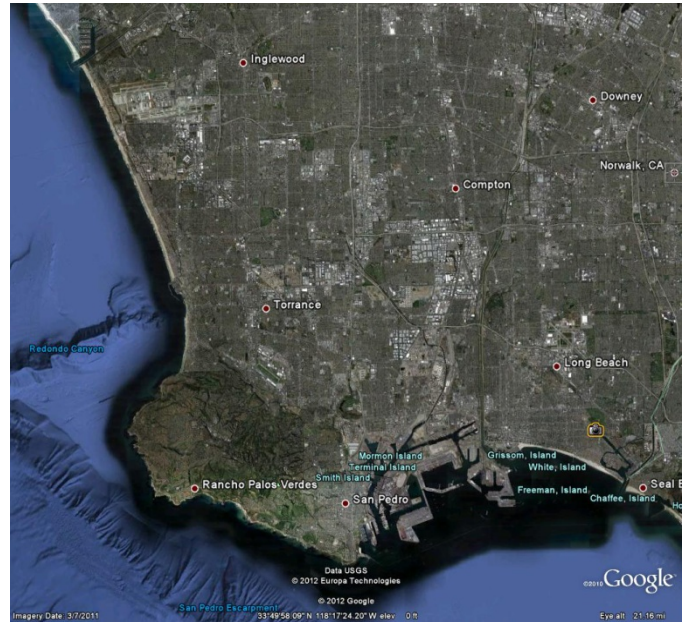
