LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

The Harbor is located approximately 40 miles southeast of the city Los Angeles and 60 miles north of the City of San Diego. Project consists of maintenance for the entrance, main, anchorage, east and west channels, the west and east breakwater and a turning basin. The Harbor is used for recreational and fishing purposes.

AUTHORIZATION:

River and Harbor Act of 1962.

ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2020:

None.

FY 2021 PLANNED ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Optimal funding could be used for plans and specifications; and environmental assessment for rock work.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION:

The Corps of Engineers performed a comprehensive condition survey of the breakwater in FY 2010, funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The project will not require funding until 2021. A recent structural walk through has identified several locations with damage that have since been raised to watch status. The locations will continue to be monitored.

The damage will be addressed and included in future budget requests.
