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LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

The study is located in the northeastern San Fernando Valley, approximately 15 miles northeast of downtown Los Angeles, California. This project would enable the Corps to complete the required environmental documentation, update the 1999 Feasibility Study, and receive formal management and command approval to change operations.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION:

Study efforts were suspended in 1999. The cost share account was closed with an imbalance of cash and work-in-kind. The County of Los Angeles (Local sponsor) wishes to provide cash to balance the cost share and has requested that the study be re-initiated. The study would determine whether requested operation changes could be accomplished. A letter requesting the balance of \$262,000 in cash has been sent to the sponsor.
