



# Little Colorado River (Winslow), AZ


## Investigations

U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS

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### LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

The project area includes a 7.2 mile flood control levee located along the Little Colorado River near Winslow, Arizona. Approximately 1,600 structures, including almost the entirety of the City's critical public facilities (hospitals, schools, nursing homes, utility infrastructure, etc.), are located within the 1% ACE (100-year) flood plan. Total population at risk: approx. 5,000 are at risk from the 0.2% ACE event. Project would rebuild sections of Ruby Wash Diversion Levee and Winslow Levee. The total length of new and reconstructed levees would be approx. 22,570'.
