LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

This Flood Control project is located in the extreme portion of southern Arizona and the central and northern portions of the city of Nogales, about 60 miles south of Tucson. The project has two separable features, a flood-warning system in Mexico and the United States and channel and Interceptor construction at Chula Vista, Arizona. Urbanization in the twin cities of Nogales, Sonora, Mexico and Nogales, Arizona, with a combined population of 500,000 has increased runoff into the Nogales Wash, causing flood and erosion problems.

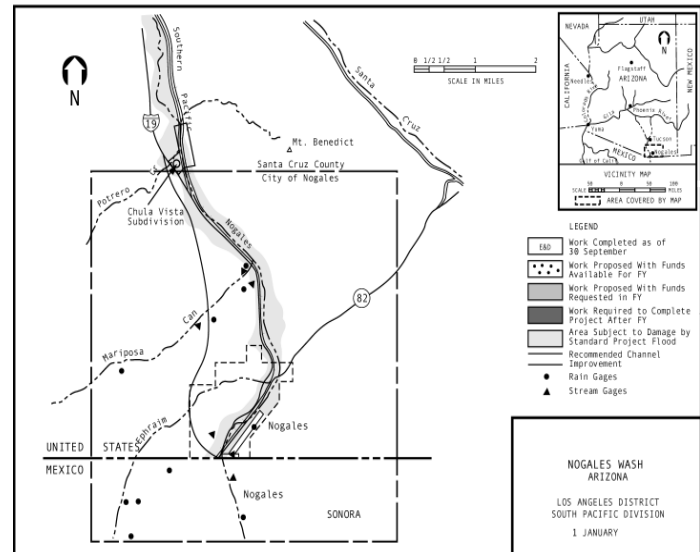
