LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

Oceanside Harbor is located on the Southern California coast, about 30 miles north of the city of San Diego, in San Diego County. The harbor is split into a commercial harbor that supports commercial fishing vessels as well as recreational boaters and a military harbor that supports operations at Marine Corps Base (MCB) Camp Pendleton.

AUTHORIZATION:

Rivers and Harbors Act of 1937, 1945.

ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2021:

Funds will be used to perform annual maintenance dredging of the harbor; anticipate dredging 400,000 cubic yards. We anticipate having the approval to dredge to 30 feet in the center of the entrance channel. This will allow the entrance to remain safe throughout the year. As it is now, it comes close to closing every year, creating unsafe conditions.

FY 2022 PLANNED ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Perform routine maintenance dredging.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION:

Cost of maintaining the harbor is split 50% with the U.S. Marine Corps to support their activities at MCB Camp Pendleton.
