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LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The study area is located entirely within the City of Phoenix, along eight miles of the Salt River, from 19th Avenue to 83rd Avenue, downstream (West or Oeste) of the ongoing Rio Salado project and upstream of the Tres Rios Project. The recommended plan includes restoration of nearly 1,500 acres of riparian and flood plain habitat with recreation and incidental flood damage reduction

AUTHORIZATION: Flood Control Act of 1938, Sec 6 (Gila River & Tributaries, AZ & NM) 28 Jun 38, HR 2425 dated 17 May 1994; Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) 2007, Sec 1001 (5).


ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2020: Carryover funds will be used to close out Rio Salado Oeste Feasibility Phase.

FY2021 PLANNED ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

Continue coordination with Non-Federal Sponsor for re-scoping Post-Authorization Change Report (PACR).

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: The Non Federal Sponsor requested the project be re-scoped to focus on riparian habitat restoration with removal of upland restoration components. PACR must prepared for project reauthorization; awaiting funding. This project is the "Highest" priority Rio Salado project for Non-Federal Sponsor.

CONGRESSIONAL INTEREST: Senators Sinema and McSally; Congressman Gallego (AZ-7).
