LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

BLUE DIAMOND: (Potential New Phase) Blue Diamond is about 10 miles southwest of Las Vegas. Project would rehabilitate a water supply system in this rural community.

SEARCHLIGHT: Approximately 60 miles south of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada. Project will focus on the design and construction of Searchlight Water and Wastewater System improvements in Clark County, Nevada.

AUTHORIZATION:

Section 595, WRDA 1999.

ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2020:

SEARCHLIGHT: Funds will be used to reimburse 75% of the construction cost to date of water supply system for Searchlight, and begin the Blue Diamond water supply improvement project.

FY 2021 PLANNED ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

SEARCHLIGHT: Carryover funds will be used to continue to reimburse 75% of the construction cost to complete construction of water supply system.

MESQUITE was completed in 2009.

TONOPAH was completed in 2007.

VIRGIN VALLEY was completed in 2011.


MOAPA was completed in 2012.
