## **LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:**

San Diego Harbor is an important military, commercial, and recreational harbor. It is home to the Port of San Diego, Navy Region Southwest, and its numerous tenant commands, commercial and military shipyards, cruise ship terminals, and thousands of recreational and commercial fishing vessels.

The federal project consists of the approach, entrance, and central channels as well as the aircraft carrier turning basin adjacent to North Island. The Zuniga jetty extending seaward from North Island is also part of the federal navigation project.

## **AUTHORIZATION:**

Rivers and Harbor Act of 1852.

## **ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2020:**

Funds will be used to perform maintenance dredging in a number of high spots in the channel. Channel is being utilized by number of commercial vessels, and the US Navy vessels as well.

Optimal Funding could be used for Donor Port.

## **ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION:**

The Zuniga Jetty is currently functioning but does create hazards to some boaters.
