San Diego Harbor is an important military, commercial, and recreational harbor. It is home to the Port of San Diego, Navy Region Southwest and its numerous tenant commands, commercial and military shipyards, cruise ship terminals, and thousands of recreational and commercial fishing vessels.

The federal project consists of the approach, entrance, and central channels as well as the aircraft carrier turning basin adjacent to North Island. The Zuniga jetty extending seaward from North Island is also part of the federal navigation project.
