LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION:

Mission Bay is located in the City of San Diego, about 5 miles northwest of the downtown area. The basic features include the navigation features seaward of the West Mission Bay Bridge. These features include the levied flood control channel at the mouth of the San Diego River, the entrance channel, main channel and turning basin, and three jetties. These facilities were substantially complete in 1959, with a subsequent extension of the south jetty in 1970.

AUTHORIZATION:

Flood Control Act of 1944 and River and Harbor Act of 1946.

ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2021:

Continued construction using funds obligated in FY20.

FY 2022 PLANNED ACCOMPLISHMENTS: None.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION:

Harbor was last dredged in FY 2011 and was funded with ARRA funds. Obstructions present within dredging footprint.
