LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The watershed area encompasses approximately 90 square miles and is located in western Orange County, 25 miles southeast of the City of Los Angeles. The study will focus on watershed management and flood risk management for two major water courses; the East Garden Grove Wintersburg (EGGW) Channel and the Westminster Channel. The watershed lies on a flat coastal plain and is almost entirely urbanized with residential and commercial development. Flood damage along the East Garden Grove-Wintersburg Channel, affect residential, commercial and industrial development within the cities of Santa Ana, Westminster, Huntington Beach and Fountain Valley.

AUTHORIZATION: Flood Control Act of 1938, House Resolution dated 6 May 1964

ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2020: Complete environmental documentation and reviews, final report, state and agency reviews and the final Chief's report.

FY21 PLANNED ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Optimal funding could be used to negotiate, sign a design agreement and initiate Pre-construction Engineering and Design.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: Study was transferred to Chicago District in 2017. Preconstruction Engineering and Design efforts are scheduled to be initiated by the Los Angeles district in FY21.
