LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Dominguez Channel is located in the county of Los Angeles, California. It was designed and constructed to provide a specific level of flood protection. Over time, urbanization and development of the tributary watersheds have increased the amount of runoff that the channel must convey. There is local interest in efforts to increase flood protection of adjacent communities. The study will assess the current and required levels of flood protection and begin the process of mitigating the increased flood risks identified along Dominguez Channel. Funding is under the Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) Section 205.

<u>AUTHORIZATION:</u> Flood Control Act of 1948 (PL 80-858), Section 205

ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2017: Carryover funds were used to complete the Federal Interest Determination (FID) and draft the Project Management Plan (PMP).

FY18 PLANNED ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Carryover funds will be used to execute the Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement (FCSA). Optimal funding would be used to continue feasibility.
