Carbon Canyon Creek Channel Golden Avenue Bridge Replacement

Requester: In compliance with U.S.C. Title 33, Chapter 9, Subchapter 1, Section 408, the City of Placentia has requested permission from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) to alter the Carbon Canyon Creek Channel.

Location:

The proposed action would replace the existing Golden Avenue Bridge over Carbon Canyon Creek Channel in the city of Placentia, Orange County, California. The proposed features are not inside the channel, and will therefore not require construction within the channel.

Requester's Proposed Action:

The City of Placentia is proposing to remove the existing Golden Avenue Bridge over Carbon Canyon Creek Channel and replace it with a new bridge. The new bridge would be approximately 82 feet 6 inches long, approximately 58 feet 4 inches wide, and would contain two traffic lanes, bike lanes/shoulders, and sidewalks. All work would be completed within the existing right of way, and construction equipment would be staged along Golden Avenue to the west and east of the bridge. Excavation to a maximum depth of 15 feet would be required to construct the cast-in-drilled-hole piles, the abutment footings, and the abutment seats. Construction would take approximately seven months. The purpose of the project is to replace a functionally obsolete bridge as determined per a Caltrans Bridge Inspection Report dated September 29, 2011. The replacement bridge is needed to provide adequate facilities to motoring and non-motoring public.

Authority: The authority to grant permission for temporary or permanent use, occupation or alteration of any USACE Civil Works project is contained in Section 14 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899, as amended, codified at 33 USC 408 ("Section 408"). Section 408 authorizes the Secretary of the Army, on the recommendation of the Chief of Engineers, to grant permission for the alteration or occupation or use of a USACE project if the Secretary determines that the activity will not be injurious to the public interest and will not impair the usefulness of the project. The Secretary of Army's authority under Section 408 has been delegated to the USACE, the Chief of Engineers. The Chief of Engineers has further delegated the authority to the USACE, Directorate of Civil Works and Division and District Engineers, depending upon the nature of the activity.

Limits of Section 408 Authority: A requester has the responsibility to acquire all other permissions or authorizations required by federal, state, and local laws or regulations, including any required permits from the USACE Regulatory Program under Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (33 USC 403), Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 USC Section 1344), and/or Section 103 of the Marine Protection, Research and Sanctuaries Act of 1972 (33 USC 1413). In addition, an approval under Section 408 does not grant any property rights or exclusive privileges nor does it authorize any injury to the property or rights of others.

Consideration of Comments: The Corps is soliciting comments from the public, Federal, State and local agencies and officials, and other interested parties. Comments will be made part of the record, and they will be considered before permission is granted to proceed with this action. Please limit comments to the area of the alteration and those adjacent areas that would be directly or indirectly affected by the alteration described in this public notice.

Submission of Comments: Interested parties may submit, in writing, any comments concerning this proposal. Comments should reference public notice no. SPL-408-PN-2019-0029 and be forwarded by the comment due date of February 5, 2020.
