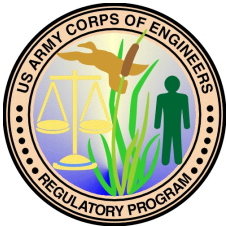
Notice of Emergency Activities Workshop

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District, Regulatory Division, South Coast Branch (Corps) is hosting a 'Emergency Activities' workshop on Tuesday, December 17, 2019. The workshop will occur in the City of San Diego's MOC II facility's auditorium space at 9192 Topaz Way. The Corps plans to cover what constitutes an emergency, pursuant to agency regulations and guidance, and the different permitting mechanisms that may be appropriate, including Regional General Permit No. 63 for Emergency Activities and Standard Permits. The purpose of the workshop is to prepare the region for winter storms, provide the correct reporting requirements in the event of an emergency, and reduce any confusion surrounding the Corps' Emergency Permitting.
