This Special Public Notice announces that the District Commander of the Los Angeles District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (“Corps”) has decided to accept and expend funds contributed by the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (“MWD”). The Los Angeles District would allocate funds internally in order to expedite processing of MWD’s Department of the Army (DA) permit application(s) in accordance with 33 U.S.C. 408<sup>1</sup> (Section 408). Though MWD would receive more expeditious reviews of their permit applications, procedural and substantive requirements of the DA permit application review process remain unchanged. The decision to accept funds does not constitute any endorsement or implied consent of the MWD’s proposed project(s); rather, it will enable Corps personnel to devote the attention required to these applications, in both a timelier and more thorough manner, benefiting both MWD and the public.
