Based on the public notice activities and conditions, ADEQ certifies the RGP63 with the condition that ADEQ receives notification if the proposed activity will occur within the ordinary high water mark of an outstanding Arizona water (OAW), an impaired or not-attaining water or a lake, pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.)
